RE: RespirTek Biodegradability Test of EarthClean ECP1 Mixed Solution per OECD

EarthClean Corporation contracted the services of RespirTek, Inc. to provide an independent testing evaluation of a product per OECD Guidelines. The purpose of testing was to validate claims that the product would biodegrade in the environment simulated in the test. The product, labeled ECP1 Mixed Solution, was received at the RespirTek testing facility in late January 2010. Testing commenced in March 2010 and was terminated in April 2010.

The test was conducted per the OECD Guideline for Testing of Chemicals – 301B CO<sub>2</sub> Evolution Test, and study protocols adhered to Louisiana Environmental Laboratory Accreditation Program Standards (LELAP). The OECD 301B method classifies greater than 60% biodegradation within a 10 day window as *Ready Biodegradability* and greater than 60% biodegradation over 28 days without meeting a 10 day window as *Ultimate Biodegradability*.

Having conducted the aforementioned test on the ECP1 Mixed Solution product, RespirTek, Inc. concludes that the product meets method requirements for **Ready Biodegradability**. The details of the test have been provided to EarthClean Corporation executive management.
